

## **Important read carefully Conditions of Entry**

**You accept these Conditions of Entry by entering or using the Taxi Facilities area.  
If you do not accept these Conditions of Entry you must not enter.**

1. You may only enter and use the Taxi Facility if your vehicle is operated pursuant to a licensed taxi service.
2. You must pay the applicable fees for use of the Taxi Facilities.
3. You acknowledge and agree that the boom gates will only open for entry and exit of a Taxi Facility if a valid electronic tag is read and accepted by the electronic tag reader.
4. You are responsible for ensuring that:
  - a. there is a valid electronic tag attached to the vehicle;
  - b. the electronic tag can be read by the electronic tag reader on entry and exit; and
  - c. the account attached to the electronic tag has sufficient funds to cover the applicable fee.
5. You must maintain and comply with the conditions of all required taxi licences (including a driver's licence and any applicable commercial vehicle licences), directions, authorities and laws.
6. You must provide proof of all required licences, authorities and permissions if requested to do so by a BAC Representative.
7. You must not refuse a valid request by a member of the public for you to provide taxi services.
8. You must not tout for the provision of a taxi service to a member of the public.
9. You must queue in the Taxi Facility in an orderly fashion and otherwise conduct yourself in a manner that does not cause disruption or interference to movement of traffic.
10. Without limiting any other right or remedy of BAC, You indemnify BAC against:
  - (a) any liability to or claim by a third party (including Your Associates); and
  - (b) all costs, expenses (including those payable to consultants, lawyers and other advisors), fines, penalties, losses and damages suffered or incurred by BAC,arising directly or indirectly out of or in connection with Your use of the Taxi Facility.
11. To the full extent permitted by law, You release BAC from liability for any claim in respect of or arising from:
  - (a) damage or injury to any person or property in the Taxi Facility, terminals or the airport;
  - (b) a Taxi Facility or any services associated with it are unavailable, congested or otherwise interrupted or malfunctioning;except to the extent that a negligent act or omission or wilful default of BAC or its employees or agents contributed to the claim.
12. To the full extent permitted by law:
  - (a) You occupy and use the Taxi Facility, Terminals and the Airport at Your own risk; and
  - (b) BAC will not be liable to the Operator or any other person for any reason howsoever caused whether in contract, tort, equity or otherwise for any special, economic or consequential loss or damage, loss of revenue, time, goodwill, data, profits, anticipated savings or opportunity.
13. You acknowledge and agree that BAC assumes no duty of care (other than any duties prescribed by law) to maintain security in relation to the Taxi Facility or verify the bona fides of any person entering, or in control of, any vehicle.

14. You must not stop or park in a disabled parking zone unless the vehicle displays a current parking permit for people with disabilities or prior written approval has been granted by BAC to assist disabled passengers.
15. You must comply with all laws and all directions given to you by a BAC representative or taxi rank officer, including any instruction to move your vehicle.
16. BAC may move or remove a vehicle for operational or safety reasons or if the vehicle is parked in an unauthorised spot. You agree to pay any reasonable costs incurred by BAC in moving or removing (as the case may be) your vehicle.
17. Access is subject to BAC's directions at all times and all users of the Taxi Facilities must comply with all signs and direction markings displayed in the Taxi Facility.
18. The Australian Road Rules and the Airports (Control of On-Airport Activities) Regulations 1997 apply and are enforced at Brisbane Airport. Fines are payable for non-compliance.
19. These Conditions of Entry are subject to the laws of Queensland, Australia and you submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Queensland situated in Brisbane.
20. For the purpose of these conditions "**Taxi Facility**" means the terminal access roads which have been designated for taxi operator's passenger drop off and collection zones by BAC and all designated holding areas, including but not limited to the central parking area and Domestic interim staging area.
