

Because airports can be very busy places with lots of people around, it is best to stay close to the adults you are with and be sure to follow their instructions.




The information desk is situated on the second level.

Self Check-In






Assisted Check-In

Bag Drop-Off

If you have used the self check-in you will then need to drop off your suitcase.

At the bag drop-off area you will need to print off a label to attach to your luggage. The instructions will be on the screen next to the conveyor belt to show you how to do this.

Only people going on flights are allowed to go through to this area, so you will need to say goodbye to anyone who came to see you off at the airport.

Secondly, the contents of your bag will need to be screened.







Waiting at the gate

This is when you need to form a line to get onto the plane.


There's no need to rush as the there will be plenty of time for everyone to get on board.

Showed your boarding pass






Boarding the Plane

Boarded Plane




Stowing your bag
