New Parallel Runway SITE ACCESS & SEAWALL WORKS



This Fact Sheet provides information about the New Parallel Runway's Site Access & Seawall works.

It details the works involved, timing and potential impact of construction to the general public.

The final construction phase of the NPR Project includes three major contracts: Site Access & Seawall Works, Dryandra Road Works and Airfield Works.

The Works:

The Site Access & Seawall works package is comprised of two components:

- 1. The works will establish construction access from Moreton Drive onto the NPR site; and
- 2. The re-establishment of a 1720m rock revetment extending from the Cribb Island Bathing Sheds to Serpentine Inlet at the Airport Foreshore, northern end of the NPR site.

Timing:

Construction has commenced on site and is expected to be completed in Q1, 2017.

Construction Contractor:

The contract has been awarded to Hall Contracting following a competitive tender process. However, should you require further information, please email info@bacmajorprojects.com.au.

Purpose:

<u>Site Access:</u> Currently, access to the NPR site is via the Central Parking Area (CPA). The construction of a site access road off Moreton Drive will allow an alternate point of entry for construction deliveries and contractors to the NPR site. Returning construction traffic will continue to depart via the CPA and Bert Hinkler Drive. The separation of construction arrival and departure traffic is an improved outcome for traffic management and safety.

Seawall:

The engineered seawall will provide protection from erosion and weather events.

Community Awareness:

Site Access:

Please be aware of works in left hand lane of Moreton Drive. Safety measures will be implemented as per an approved traffic guidance scheme when any impact on Moreton Drive is expected. Signage will be utilised leading up to any changed traffic conditions to notify motorists.

Seawall:

While restricted access applies to the Airport Foreshore, any community member accessing the foreshore area should be aware of any signage indicating changed conditions due to construction works.

Community patience throughout the construction period is greatly appreciated.
