



# STAKEHOLDER NOTICE

## CCTV Inspection – Sewer & Trade Waste System

Issued: 5 November 2019

To ensure the long-term performance of both the International and Domestic terminal wastewater network, CCTV investigations of these services will be undertaken throughout November 2019.

### PURPOSE

To investigate the current condition of our wastewater network within the terminals to ensure long-term performance.

### WORKS PROGRAM

- An inspection of the Terminal (both DTB & ITB) sewer and trade waste systems will be conducted from 5 – 27 November 2019
- Localised pipes will be isolated temporarily, however the sewer services will remain operational during throughout the works
- Work areas will be cordoned off by barricades and signage (if required).

#### International Terminal

- Works will be conducted from Tuesday 5 November – Friday 8 November between 10am and 4pm
- There will be no impact to vehicular traffic or parking for the general public

#### Domestic Terminal

- Works will occur between Tuesday 12 November – Wednesday 27 November on night shift (10pm – 4am)
- There will be no impact to vehicular traffic or parking for the general public
- Pedestrians may experience slight impact at the DTB forecourt, though given the timing of works this impact is expected to be minimal
- Works will commence in public areas and progress to airside from week commencing Monday 18 November.
