- (b) It is a condition of an AUA that the Vehicle comply with the Airside Drivers Handbook and the Airports (Control of On-Airport Activities) Regulations 1997 ("Regulations");
- (c) Failure by the Vehicle to comply with the Handbook or the Regulations may result in the AUA being suspended or withdrawn;
- (d) I have taken out and will keep current public liability insurance, vehicle insurance and all other insurances as required by BAC, on terms as set out in the Airside Drivers Handbook and as reasonably required by BAC. In particular, the insurance must:
 - (i) be taken out with a reputable insurer;

 - b. AUD \$50 million for vehicles accessing Runways, Taxiways and Aircraft Manoeuvring Areas to conduct construction works/repairs, and
- (v) does not contain any exclusionary clauses relating to any airport infrastructure, aircraft or matters relating to or in connection with the operation of vehicles on the Airside, and contains an 'airside endorsement'.
- (e) With this application, I have provided BAC with a copy of:
 - (i) all relevant certificates of insurance;
