

# AVIATION DEVELOPMENT & PARTNERSHIPS REPORT

## 2020/21 FINANCIAL YEAR



### Start of FY21

- Australia closed to non-residents
- Capped international arrivals and mandatory two-week quarantine in place

### July 2020

- Queensland open to all states other than VIC
- Victoria reimposes city lockdown

### October 2020

- 16<sup>th</sup> October a one-way Trans-Tasman bubble to NSW, ACT and NT opens
- Australian economy in recession

### August 2020

- VIC declares state of disaster
- Queensland re-closes to NSW and ACT

### November 2020

- Australia records first day of zero cases
- South Australia outbreak leads to Queensland border closure

### December 2020

- 1<sup>st</sup> December Queensland borders re-open to NSW and VIC
- 20<sup>th</sup> December – Northern Beaches cluster closes Queensland border to Greater Sydney

### February 2021

- Domestic network begins to rebuild as Queensland opens to NSW, VIC in lockdown
- 5<sup>th</sup> February international caps for Queensland are restored to 1,000 per week

### March 2021

- 29<sup>th</sup> March Brisbane 3-day lockdown
- Queensland international arrival caps halved

### April and May 2021

- 19<sup>th</sup> April two-way Trans-Tasman bubble opens
- Domestic borders re-open to Queensland
- Strongest domestic network operations and schedule for the YTD

### June 2021

- Queensland closes border to Greater Sydney and VIC
- 26<sup>th</sup> June New Zealand suspends Trans-Tasman bubble
- June 29<sup>th</sup> Brisbane 3-day lockdown
